



Fact Sheet:

Deceptions and Myths: Article V Promoters want a "Limited Convention"

1. Art. V Convention promoters say the problem with the Republic is our federal servants are not following the Constitution. They say changing the Constitution will solve the problem.
2. Our public servants' disobedience is just a symptom of the root problem which is: "We the People" are not holding our public servants (federal or state) accountable for not upholding their sacred oath to God to support and protect the Constitution.
3. We citizens need to take back control of our public servants by holding them accountable before we can regain control of the general government.
4. Promoters such as the Convention of States (COS) say they want a limited convention.¹
5. The COS' "sample application" calls for a convention to do three things the second item is: "... **limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government...**"² (Numbering and emphasis added.)
6. The very purpose of the Constitution is to set the limits on the "*power and jurisdiction of the federal government...*" Therefore, these words open the entire Constitution up to change.
7. When they try to lessen fears that the entire Constitution will be up for change by saying they want to limit a convention to a "single subject" that subject is the Constitution. How is that for a unlimited limited" convention!
